## ***Fine Wine Coravin Selection By The Glass***

Coravin system helps to prevent wine from oxidation and presents us opportunity to treat our guests with fine wines of the world by the glass. Coravin Needle gently passes through corks without displacing cork material. Once the Needle is removed, the cork simply expands back to its normal shape. As wine is extracted through the Needle, it is replaced with pure Argon gas, ensuring oxygen never touches the remaining wine, keeping it as fresh as the day it was bottled.
